

### Publishable Summary

Following the deliverable D1.3 Initial Data Knowledge and Management Plan, the aim of this document is to revise and update the data and knowledge management policies of AMYPAD, especially referring to research data quality, sharing and security, in coordination with the European Prevention of Alzheimer's Dementia (EPAD) Project and other collaborative studies.

The document refers to the two studies which are running under AMYPAD, i.e., the Diagnostic Study and the Prognostic and Natural History Study. It also includes provisions for data generated outside of AMYPAD but shared with the Consortium, as these datasets shall also follow the standards defined in the project both for management and storage.

In this document it is possible to find the strategy adopted by AMYPAD regarding making data FAIR (Findable, Attainable, Interoperable and Reproducible), including provisions for data storage, sharing and long term preservation, as well as for standard methodology and nomenclature conventions.

As indicated by our initial plan, a number of decisions were adapted or further developed within the project's lifetime, and while most have been fully established and are operational, there is still room for modifications by project's end if the necessity presents itself.

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
