

Report on synergies with other Initiatives

Publishable Summary

Over the past 6 years, AMYPAD has grown into an extensive collaborative framework, bringing together researchers across Europe and several parent cohorts. In addition, we have established scientific collaborations with scientific international partners, including the IDEAS study from the United States and the PET neuroimaging group from Seoul Korea. In addition, there is a tight collaboration between AMYPAD and independent initiatives for data integration, harmonization, and exploration. Regarding the first two, AMYPAD has worked extensively with the ARIDHIA team and took advantage of the ADDI platform enabling access to the Prognostic and Natural History Study data-set within, and later beyond, the consortium. Collaboration with ADDI is expected to be expanded in the post-IMI period, to further support data governance, curation, and access. This is also a key aspect of our sustainability efforts (see deliverable 1.9 for an extensive overview on this topic). All these synergies are described at length in a paper submitted for a special issue of the Frontiers in Neurology, focused on IMI projects.

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
