

### Report on AMYPAD sustainability plan

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#### Publishable Summary

Over the past 6 years, AMYPAD has grown into an extensive collaborative framework, bringing together researchers across Europe and 11 parent cohorts, established scientific collaborations with international partners, tight collaborations with independent initiatives for data integration, harmonization, and exploration, and collected over 3500 amyloid-PET scans across the AD continuum. In the last year of the project, the focus has been put into sustaining all aspects that made the consortium successful. To streamline our goals, we had a meeting on sustainability in early June under the supervision of the independent agency 'the Forward group'. From this meeting, 3 main assets were identified: 1) the collaborative framework, 2) the generated data, and 3) the developed software. Regarding the data, three aspects were identified as necessary or possible future avenues: 1) maintenance and curation of the database, 2) addition of readily available data to the existing database, and 3) collection of additional data. This document provides the plans, achievements, and initiatives proposed to accommodate these goals. In addition, sustainability plans regarding project communication and dissemination are also provided.

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
